
GOOGY BAG 2- RABBIT.



All in two strands of thread unless stated otherwise.

You need 14" x 1/4" wide ric-rac.
I've used the beautiful Cottage Garden Threads
variegated ric-rac number 1101.

- Trace the design onto your chosen stitching fabric, making sure the design is centred and positioned 3/4" from the top edge.
- Fuse the stabiliser to the back of the design.
 Use the table below to embroider the design.

Rabbit- outline (head, arms, feet) 420 backstitch.
Pants outline- 304 backstitch.
Shading on pants- one strand 304 running stitch.
Bow tie- 304 satin stitch.
Eye- 310 satin stitch
Whiskers- one strand 310 backstitch.
Nose- 760 satin stitch.

Inside ear- 760 backstitch.

Tail- three strands Blanc colonial knots as a filler.

Chicken:

Body outline and wing-725 backstitch. Shading on body- One strand

725 straight stitch.

Tail- 725 lazy daisy stitch. Eye- 310 satin stitch. Beak- 970 satin stitch. Umbrella- top 304 backstitch. Handle- 420 backstitch.

Egg wagon:
Outline- 760 backstitch
Shading on wagon- one strand

760 running stitch.
Crosses- 964 cross stitch
(stitch over the 760 running stitch).
Handle- 420 backstitch.
Wheels- outline 420 backstitch.
Spokes on wheels- 420 straight stitch.
Hub cap- 420 backstitch.
Grass- 3364 straight stitch.

Cottage Garden Variegated threads: Sweet Pea.

I've put colonial knots
around the edge of
the bag in the ric-rac
in "Sweet Pea".
