# 5 Rose Corner Designs

— Perfect for Handkerchiefs & Linens —

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Inside this PDF you will find one overview sheet, five enlarged corner patterns, suggested stitches, and DMC colour options for a soft vintage rose palette.

Printing tip: print at 100% for the original pattern size, or enlarge slightly on a copier for bolder placement on larger linens.

## How to Use These Rose Corner Designs

These rose motifs were designed to sit neatly into the corner of a handkerchief or linen piece. Transfer the design using your favourite method - a light box, wash-away transfer pen, prick-and-pounce, or printable transfer sheet. For a classic finish, outline the design in split stitch or stem stitch, work the petals in long and short stitch or satin stitch, and fill the leaves with fishbone, satin stitch, or simple angled straight stitches.

Suggested fabric: white linen, cotton lawn, cotton handkerchief fabric, vintage napkins, or lightweight tea towels.

Needles: embroidery crewel sizes 7-9 for two strands, or size 9-10 for one strand.

Thread: stranded cotton in 1-2 strands for delicate handkerchief work, 2-3 strands for guest towels and display linens.

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Overview sheet: all five corner motifs together for quick selection and planning.

## Quick DMC Rose Palette

Area	Suggested DMC codes
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Blush pink petals	3716, 761, 818, 819
Deeper pink shadows	760, 3726, 3328
Leaf greens	3051, 3052, 3345, 3346, 3347
Stem and vine greens	3363, 3364, 367, 3021

## English Garden Cascade

A soft double-rose corner with leafy balance and a gentle trailing flourish. Lovely on handkerchief corners, pillow slips, or dresser scarves.



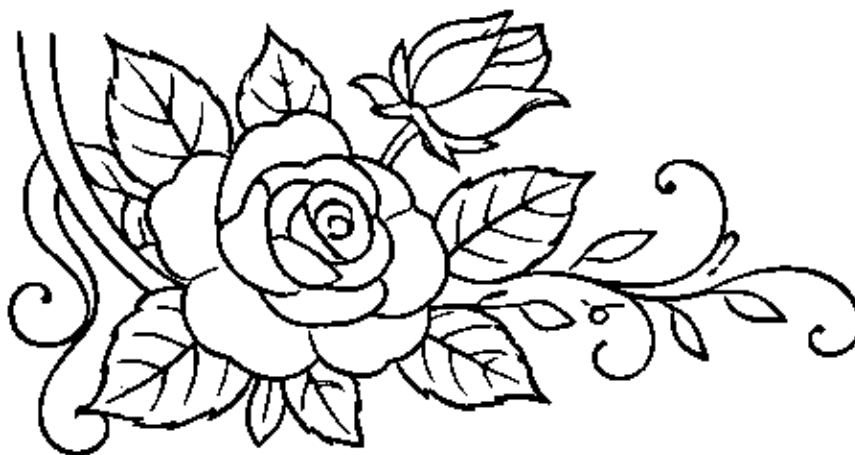
Suggested stitches: split stitch or stem stitch for outlines; long and short stitch or satin stitch for petals; fishbone stitch or angled satin stitch for leaves; backstitch for fine detail.

Element	Suggested DMC options
Rose petals	3716 / 761 / 818
Rose shadows	3726 / 819
Leaves	3345 / 3346 / 3052
Stems & curls	3363 / 3364

Tip: for a more delicate heirloom look, stitch the roses in one strand and keep the greenery soft and light. For a bolder guest towel version, use two strands and deepen the shadows with one darker pink.

## Climbing Rose Sweep

A wider sweep with a side rosebud and airy scrollwork, ideal for larger linen corners where you want the design to travel along the hem.



Suggested stitches: split stitch or stem stitch for outlines; long and short stitch or satin stitch for petals; fishbone stitch or angled satin stitch for leaves; backstitch for fine detail.

Element	Suggested DMC options
Rose petals	818 / 819 / 761
Rosebud	3328 / 819
Leaves	3051 / 3052 / 3346
Stems & tendrils	3363 / 367

Tip: for a more delicate heirloom look, stitch the roses in one strand and keep the greenery soft and light. For a bolder guest towel version, use two strands and deepen the shadows with one darker pink.

## Twin Rose Spray

Two clustered roses with compact foliage for a slightly fuller, heirloom-style finish. Works beautifully on napkins and tray cloths.



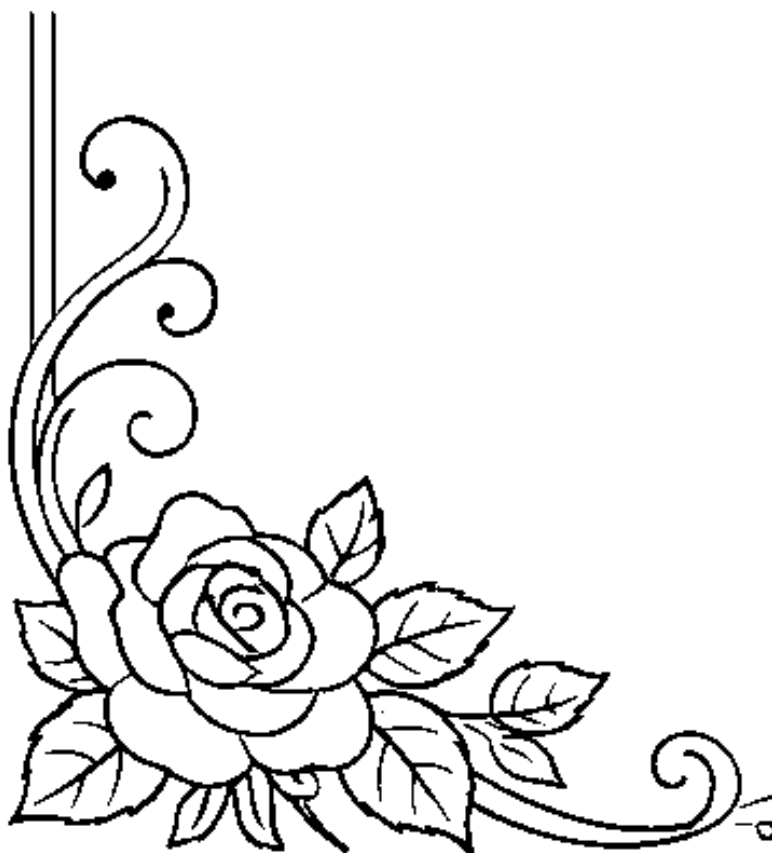
Suggested stitches: split stitch or stem stitch for outlines; long and short stitch or satin stitch for petals; fishbone stitch or angled satin stitch for leaves; backstitch for fine detail.

Element	Suggested DMC options
Rose petals	761 / 760 / 3716
Rose centers	3726
Leaves	3345 / 3052 / 3347
Stems	3363 / 3364

Tip: for a more delicate heirloom look, stitch the roses in one strand and keep the greenery soft and light. For a bolder guest towel version, use two strands and deepen the shadows with one darker pink.

## Heirloom Rose Vine

A classic corner arrangement with one main bloom and graceful vine movement. A nice choice for vintage-inspired linens.



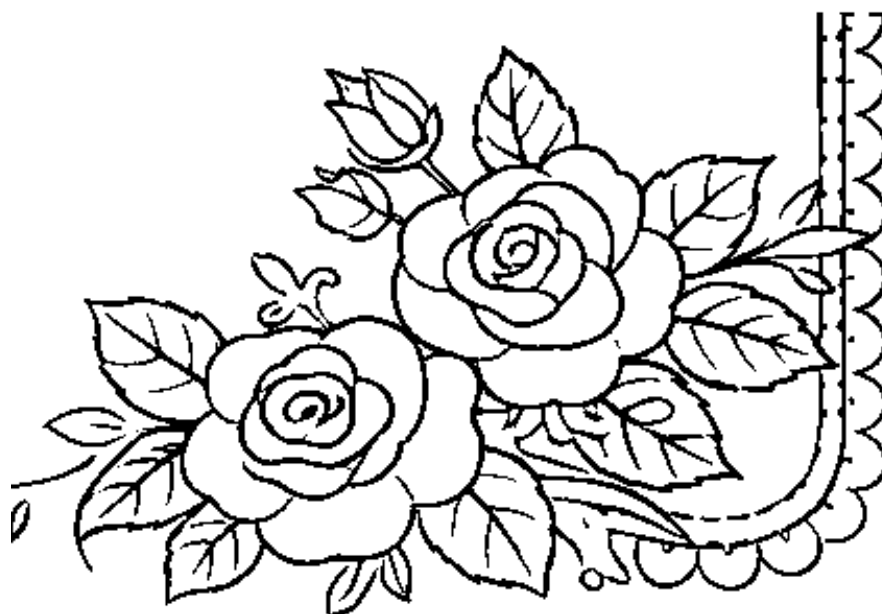
Suggested stitches: split stitch or stem stitch for outlines; long and short stitch or satin stitch for petals; fishbone stitch or angled satin stitch for leaves; backstitch for fine detail.

Element	Suggested DMC options
Rose petals	818 / 819 / 3328
Highlights	762
Leaves	3346 / 3052 / 3364
Stem line	3363

Tip: for a more delicate heirloom look, stitch the roses in one strand and keep the greenery soft and light. For a bolder guest towel version, use two strands and deepen the shadows with one darker pink.

## Lace Edge Rose Corner

A decorative version with lace-style edge framing. Perfect for decorative guest towels or dresser keepsake handkerchiefs.



Suggested stitches: split stitch or stem stitch for outlines; long and short stitch or satin stitch for petals; fishbone stitch or angled satin stitch for leaves; backstitch for fine detail.

Element	Suggested DMC options
Rose petals	3716 / 761 / 760
Small buds	818 / 819
Leaves	3051 / 3052 / 3346
Stem & border detail	3363 / 3021

Tip: for a more delicate heirloom look, stitch the roses in one strand and keep the greenery soft and light. For a bolder guest towel version, use two strands and deepen the shadows with one darker pink.
